## **OUR PROGRAMS**

### **BIKE SCHOOL**

Our Bike School programs, including Bike Institute, Earn-A-Bike, and Sisters in Action, provide five- to eight-week courses designed to teach young people basic bike mechanics, how to refurbish bikes, and safe urban riding. Through these programs, students earn their own bike and may also graduate to take on an apprenticeship or earn a job in our Bike Shop.

## YOUTH PATHWAYS & EMPLOYMENT

Graduates of our Bike School programs may choose to take on a three-year, paid apprenticeship working in our Bike School, Bike Shop, and Bicyclists Organizing for Community Action (BOCA) program.

#### **BIKE SHOP**

In addition to providing meaningful jobs and mentorship, our full-service Bike Shop provides expert repair services as well as high-quality new and refurbished bikes at affordable prices. The shop rebuilds hundreds of reclaimed bicycles each year and provides a consistent, reliable source of funding for BNB's youth and international programs.

### **BIKE-A-THON**

Our annual Bike-A-Thon is our largest community event and fundraiser bringing together hundreds of riders and volunteers in support of a thriving, equitable bike culture, locally and globally. The Bike-A-Thon offers multiple routes from 10 to 100 miles, as well as volunteer opportunities and a family-friendly after party with live music, food, and fun.

### COMMUNITY SERVICES

Through our bike recycling program, we accept donated bikes to be refurbished and redistributed through local and international social justice projects. Since 1984, we have shipped over 82,000 bicycles to partners in 14 countries in the Global South. Right here in Boston, we also "match" people in need to a free bicycle to help them attend school, get to work, or care for family members.
