



We're thrilled to share that **Bikes Not Bombs** was recently honored by the **City of Boston City Council** during Pedestrian Safety Month, thanks to an invitation from Councilor Enrique Pepén, with BNB CEO Elijah Evans proudly representing the organization.

This recognition highlights the critical work being driven by our **BOCA** (**Bicyclists Organizing for Community Action**) campaigns, which are essential to our mission for transportation justice. Our advocacy efforts include **Bikes 4 All**, ensuring cycling access for everyone; **Wheels to Wellness**, promoting health through safe transit to essential services; the **Safer Streets Now** campaign, pushing for vital infrastructure changes like protected bike lanes; and our **Community Advisory Council**, which holds monthly

meetings to ensure our actions are directly

guided by community needs.

We celebrate this honor as a testament to the power of our community to create a safer, more equitable city for all cyclists and pedestrians.
